SPIRITUAL PREP AUGUST 2-4, 2019

Our Spiritual Prep time for the Kansas WW Weekend will be about joy. God's joy! The fruit of the Spirit of Joy! Consider this spiritual prep to be God's invitation to meet with Him in prayer and learn more about joy. May it be a time to clear out what needs to be cleared out to make more room for His joy so we may arrive at the weekend prepared to be His vessels.

We will be using one song per week for our prayer preparation. Each song reflects on the fruit of the Spirit of joy. Through the gift of song, we will practice listening with the ear of our hearts; keeping in mind our scripture ...

*The Lord is my strength and my shield and my heart trusts in Him. He helps me.
My heart leaps for joy, and with my song I praise Him. (Ps 28:7)*

Let the songs wash over you. Let them sink into you. Soak in them! Listen for the word, phrase, or feeling He highlights for you. Trust Him to guide you and stay with what He draws you to. Listen to each week's song, daily if possible; in the morning, in the car, while you do the laundry or load the dishwasher. Pray with the song, wherever and whenever you can.

The song "Joy of the Lord" by Rend Collective will be the song for week #4. It is our feature song for the Kansas Women's Walk weekend. So, if life gets crazy and you find you only have time for one song, please make sure you spend time with this one. I trust there is a reason God picked it for us.

I have put together a play list for your convenience and I have included the lyrics to each song so you may use the words for your prayer time. If you feel inclined, you can find a scripture that fits for the word, phrase or feeling these songs stir for you. So many of the lines of these songs have corresponding scriptures. Find them.

At the end of each day or week, I invite you to write down in a journal what word or phrase the song has stirred in you. Include a scripture if you felt called to look one up. Then at the end of each week I am asking that you do an e-mail check in with your prayer partner. Share one awareness or blessing from your time with God that week.
