



Qualifications to be an At Home Prayer (AHPT) Team Co/Leader

Ephesians 6:18 “And pray in the Spirit on all occasions, with all kinds of prayers and requests. With this in mind, be alert and always keep on praying for all the saints. (NIV)

Romans 8:27 “And He who searches our hearts knows the mind of the Spirit, because the Spirit intercedes for the saints in accordance with God’s will.” (NIV)

When a Sister senses the call of the LORD to be an AHPT Co/Leader, we ask that she prays over these qualifications, as she seeks the leading of the Holy Spirit, for this leadership role in our WWWC ministry.

1. Engages in a vibrant personal prayer life and love of Jesus
2. Completes a WWWC Weekend, Bridge, and commits to regularly attending a Spirit Circle
3. Prayerfully considers this role, recognizing the spiritual warfare
4. Desires to intercede on behalf of the missionaries and staff
5. Organizes and commits to the AHPT, 2 - 3 weeks prior to the Weekend.
6. Has prior experience praying intentionally as a member of several WWWC At Home Prayer Teams. Skill set includes: sending AHPT resources electronically before and throughout the Weekend.
